

ACCOUNTABILITY COMMITTEE -MEETING MINUTES  
OCTOBER 11, 2023

The October meeting of the Elbert Accountability Committee was called to order at 4:30 p.m. by Kelli Thompson. The September minutes were presented and approved. The agenda was approved as presented.

**Reports:**

Student Leadership - STUCO report was on the Homecoming events that occurred during the Homecoming week. They did an amazing job and the wagon float parade seems to be a hit.

School Board - Tracy Ardrey gave a full report, highlighting the National FFA convention trip and the staff extra duty stipend to be given in October. See board minutes for details.

Administration - Enrollment 275ish. Parent/teacher conferences were held on 10/9/2023 with 95% turnout for elementary and 28 total parent turnout for 6th - 12th. We tried conferences before the end of the quarter hoping parents would help their children complete assignments and have better overall grades for the the end of the quarter. Discipline has been pretty routine.

Sub-committees - No report.

**Action and Discussion:**

Oversight of SB 191 – 1338 Council - All Professional Growth Plans have been submitted and approved. Mr. Aragon came to the meeting to present an overview of the evaluation process.

Preschool Oversight - Kathy has worked diligently to spend all the preschool grant money - the big purchase has been the new technology. The UPK rollout is still in process and has been somewhat of a mess, but our students are attending and Kathy will be rolling out 1st quarter reports by the 20th and offering parent conferences at that time.

Healthy School Index - Both the middle school and high school completed the survey. The survey seemed to ask some sexual orientation questions despite the district opting out of the survey with sexual questions. Numerous parents voiced their concerns. The district administration has decided Elbert will no longer participate in this survey in the future.

Unified Improvement Plan - The UIP will not be required for this year. The elementary received a distinguished rating and the secondary is at the performance level.

School Climate Survey - No report. Surveys will be conducted in March with Parent/Teacher Conferences.
